

## **PARENTS WANTED FOR BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT COMMITTEE**

In response to growing student enrollments and the resulting imbalance across Sherwood School District elementary schools, we would like your help in adjusting our current attendance boundaries.

The District needs two parents from each elementary to form a new Boundary Committee that will meet to collaborate together and establish recommendations for boundary adjustments.

This committee will recommend:

- *Attendance boundaries for all elementary schools in the District  
(changes are needed to balance enrollment between them)*

Approximately 5-6 committee meetings will be held from August 2019 through January 2020.

The committee will give its recommendations to the District superintendent, who will then make a final recommendation to the Board of Directors. Approved changes to the boundaries throughout the district will be effective with the 2020-21 school year.
